Legal Needs Assessment Working Group Recommendations

NC IOLTA awards grants to provide civil legal aid for low-income individuals and other programs designed to improve the administration of justice. In 2023, NC IOLTA will distribute over \$6.1 million in grants through the regular IOLTA grant cycle. Additionally, NC IOLTA is distributing \$1.5 million over the next two years to support implementation of the final recommendations identified by the Legal Needs Assessment working groups.
